<p>Coaching Report: Tracey reports that numbers at Go-ride are not consistent at this time of year, due to children's differing interest and family issues. This impacts and makes attendance numbers low. Consideration being given to using Hammerstones circuit which is available on a Saturday afternoon from 2pm. Tracey will speak with parents first but it is hoped to run a joint session- children and adult riders. Members will pay a subsidised fee.</p>	TC

<p>Club runs- groupings seem to be settled at B short, B long, C short, D and gravel group.</p> <p>Ride with GPS- The club will explore the use of 'Events' in Ride with GPS over the next few weeks to see if it is a more effective means of communicating ride details to members.</p> <p>It has the potential to simplify the posting of routes; improving route selection by members and enabling better long term planning. It is recognised that some people may need technical support, and so we will continue to use WhatsApp and Facebook alongside the 'Events' trial for the time being.</p> <p>Note that ride write ups are popular and should continue to be shared on club facebook page.</p> <p>Away days are becoming a regular monthly feature and this method of advertising rides has been very useful in communicating info to interested parties.</p>	RN / AB
