Nicky to update the website.</p> <p><b>RWGPS-</b> Several areas of the club website could be updated and linked to RWGPS in order to give more consistency and useful information. <p>&gt; The process for purchasing kit will be:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; 1) Select the item of kit you wish to purchase on membermojo.</li> <li>&gt; 2) Make your purchase using a debit card, or credit card.</li> <li>&gt; 3) Once the purchase has been completed you will receive a payment receipt.</li> <li>&gt; 4) Take the receipt to Albion Cycles, to collect your purchase.</li> </ul> <p>&gt; All kit must be purchased prior to collection, this will help the club to keep track of the available stock and re-order items when required.</p> <p>&gt; You will no longer be able to purchase kit at Albion using cash.</p> <p>&gt; Should you wish to try the stock for size prior to purchase you can do this by visiting Albion Cycles, but you must then make your purchase through membermojo.</p> <p>&gt; If you are unsure how to purchase an item using membermojo, instructions are:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; 1) sign into the system</li> <li>&gt; 2) select Your membership from the top bar.</li> <li>&gt; 3) Select Store Purchase -this will take you to all the items available to buy.</li> <li>&gt; 4) Select the item you wish to purchase, then select the correct size.</li> <li>&gt; 5) Pay for the item.</li> </ul> <p>Stuart to be added to membermojo admin so he gets notice of payments for kit and can then update the accounts.</p>	TC SB
